Our Objects

The "Southern Cross Air Force" was formed for the purpose of fostering and advancing the construction and operation of radio controlled Warbird Aircraft of all sizes in a setting where informality and safety of operations prevail.

It has been formed to create an atmosphere where pleasure, recreation, fellowship, and co-mingling can be fostered and found to exist amongst individuals who enjoy the sport of building and flying radio controlled Warbird Aircraft.

It was also formed to foster and promote the building and flying of Warbird Aircraft amongst young aeromodellers.

WARBIRD AIRCRAFT: The SCAF defines a 'Warbird Aircraft' as a model of any aircraft used for military purposes by any country at any time. It must be a scale or semi-scale rendering, recognizable as such, and marked accordingly. Any prototype offered to the military but not accepted by them would also fall into this category. ARF Warbirds are also quite acceptable assuming that they display a good scale quality. Scale military helicopters also fall into the Warbird Aircraft class.

EVENTS:

1. Members are encouraged to participate in SCAF events which are held at the airfield of our host clubs.
2. Members attending a SCAF event are encouraged to make themselves known to their fellow members and are invited to attend the short business meeting which is held during the event.
3. Members attending a SCAF event are required to abide by the rules of the host club.
4. Members wishing to participate in a SCAF event must be prepared to show their current SCAF membership card as well as proof of current membership of an Australian aeromodelling association which provides the Public Liability Insurance acceptable to the host club and/or event organizers.
5. A member controlling any aircraft must be able to display flying skills equal to 'Gold Wings' standard.

MEMBERSHIP: Membership of the Southern Cross Air Force **expires on the 30th June**, each year.

FEE STRUCTURE: Senior Joining Fee \$10.00 Senior Fee \$30.00 = Total Senior Fee \$40.00
Junior Membership is FREE

An applicant whose 18th birthday (or earlier year) falls within the current financial year namely between 1st July to 30th June is deemed to hold 'Junior Membership' for that year.

An Invoice-Receipt showing the Membership Card will be posted to the applicant after the application and the fee have been received.
